Other questions that may be helpful

1. Why does the district need new buildings and how will these facilities affect student learning/achievement?
2. What criteria was used to assess the buildings? Were these adequate?
3. How were the buildings prioritized for renovation/construction?
4. What was the rationale for closing a particular building?
5. How does the district intend to maintain the integrity of excellent academic programs housed in schools that are slated for consolidation?
6. What do state monies fund and what will be funded locally?
7. How much will this cost? For example, how much will any proposed bond issue cost the owner of a \$100,000 home?
8. What contingencies exist for cost overruns?
9. How will the district guarantee the quality of the construction?
10. If the schools are in disrepair, how and why did they get that way and how will the district guarantee that this will not happen again (i.e. how will it maintain the new/renovated buildings)?
