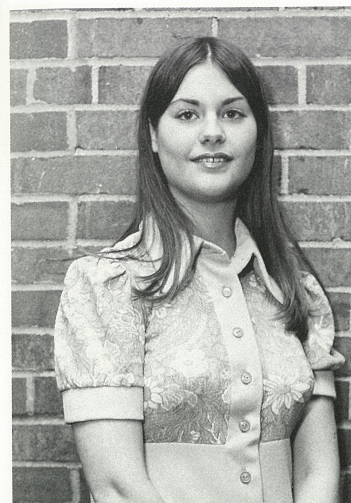
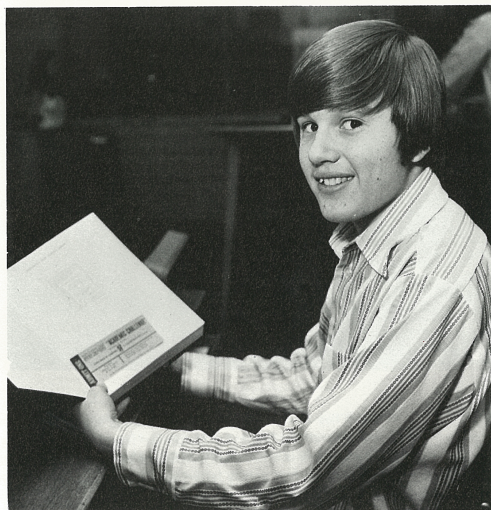
SANDY MARKOVICH — Third

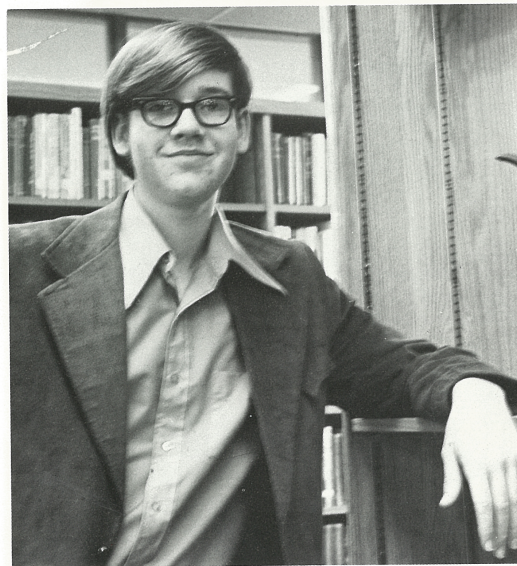
DONNA SALHANY — Fifth

Richard finished ninth in the senior class with an average of 3.78. One of Richard's main interests is woodworking. He has been an active participant in Student Council and other student action groups.



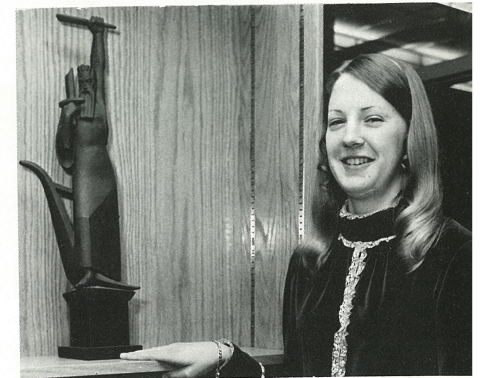
DENISE REDMAN — Eighth

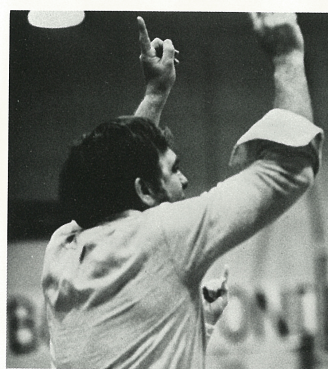
These five young men captured another Sectional Championship for Springfield by beating Firestone and Garfield.

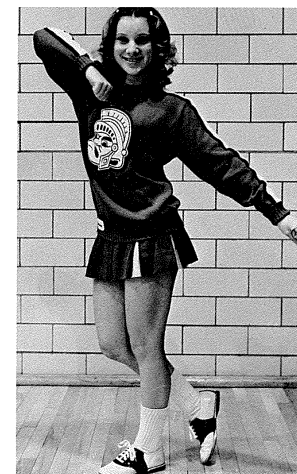
CHEERLEADERS
