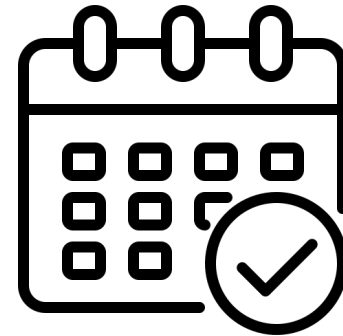

IN PERSON ATTENDANCE LEARNING PLAN

FIVE DAYS PER WEEK



1

FACIAL COVERINGS

All staff and students grades K-12 will wear face coverings unless a medical provider recommends otherwise.



2

ACADEMIC BENEFITS

The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends in person school, reporting that the benefits of school attendance outweigh the risks of COVID-19 for youth.

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL & MENTAL WELLNESS

School counselors and mental health professionals will be available to students in each model of learning. Classroom teachers will prioritize students' well being.

HEALTH SCREENINGS

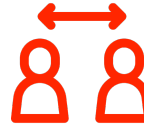
Students and staff will conduct a self-assessment daily before arriving at school. Anyone with a fever of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher, or experiencing symptoms, should not come to school.

STAY HOME WHEN SICK

Having staff and students together in school is a partnership with parents. Quarantine and isolation protocols will be enforced for anyone displaying symptoms of COVID-19, has tested positive, or has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive.

SOCIAL DISTANCING - DISINFECTING

Individuals will be spaced 3 feet apart when possible. Signage will be visible throughout the schools. Classrooms will be disinfected daily. Students 4-12 will disinfect work areas between class changes.

CAFETERIA SAFETY

Cafeteria lines will be distanced and lunch room space may expand to other areas to maintain social distance. Cleaning and disinfecting will be done after every lunch period.



8

VOLUNTEERS & VISITORS

Only essential visitors will be permitted inside facilities. Any volunteer programs are suspended until further notice.



9

HAND WASHING & SANITIZING

Hand sanitizer will be available in every classroom and in common areas. Students and staff will be trained in proper hand washing and required to wash hands throughout the day.



10

TRANSPORTATION

Riders will be required to wear face coverings and assigned a seat. Everyone will be required to sanitize hands upon entry. Busses will be disinfected daily, with common areas disinfected between routes. Two riders will be permitted per seat.

ONLINE LEARNING PLAN

SPRINGFIELD ONLINE ACADEMY
SEMESTER-LONG DISTANCE LEARNING ALTERNATIVE



1 ACADEMIC SCHEDULE

Students have the opportunity to opt-in for distance learning for the first semester of the 20-21 school year. This plan will be aligned but not synchronized with classrooms in the traditional setting, therefore a student's commitment to participate in the online learning plan must be for a semester at a time.



2 ACADEMIC BENEFITS

Online learning provides continued learning for students at a higher health risk or strongly opposed to physical school attendance during the pandemic.



3 SOCIAL EMOTIONAL & MENTAL WELLNESS

A Springfield educator will facilitate the learning of each student through daily interactions. Students will continue to have access to school counselors for social emotional and academic counseling.



4 LEARNING PLATFORM

Instruction will be provided through computer-based programs and teacher-created lessons. Students will connect with teachers and peers in meaningful ways through Google Classroom, video recordings, live streaming, and other appropriate means of online interaction.



5 TIME EXPECTATION

It is essential that students log-in daily, keep up with assignments, attend scheduled distance meetings, respond to feedback provided by the teacher, and complete projects in a timely manner.



6 SPECIAL EDUCATION

Students will continue to receive special education services in the distance setting.



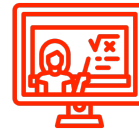
7 COURSEWORK

Students will be assigned classes (7-12) or homeroom (K-6) to create continuity. Online curriculum and Google Classroom will be used for meaningful interactions. Some electives will not be available.



8 DEVICES / INTERNET

Students are welcome to use their own personal device, or request to borrow a device from the district. Parents are expected to provide reliable high speed internet for students to access their courses.



9 TEACHERS

Instructional delivery will be supported by Springfield Local teachers who will be assigned to online learning classrooms.



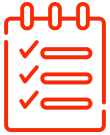

ACADEMIC SCHEDULE

Assigned classes, teachers and academic schedule will remain the same.

ACADEMIC BENEFITS

A remote learning platform allows for continued learning when in person interaction is not possible.

LEARNING PLATFORM

All remote learning will be accessed through Google Classroom, including classroom communications, collaboration, instruction, coursework and notifications.

SOCIAL EMOTIONAL & MENTAL WELLNESS

Resources will be available to support students' needs while learning from home, including their school counselors and additional mental health personnel.



5

TIME EXPECTATION

Time spent in remote learning will not exceed instructional time spent during the traditional school day.



6

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Students will continue to receive special education services in the remote setting.



7

DEVICES / INTERNET

Students are welcome to use their own personal device, or request to borrow a device from the district. Parents are expected to provide reliable high speed internet for students to access their courses.



8

TEACHER ACCESSIBILITY

Teachers will be accessible and active throughout the school day via Google Classroom and email.

STUDENT SAFETY

School Resource Officers will participate in classes (rotating) and present safety related content in an age appropriate manner.
